We use a foster to adopt contract on animals that are being adopted, and the adopter agrees to bring the animal back for us to get spayed or neutered, or to take it to a local vet we work with to get spayed or neutered. When they do not do this within the period of time, that is how the animals are classified, but we still contact the adopter to work on spaying and neutering of the animal. Hope this helps.
