

**CONTRACT FOR ANIMAL SHELTER
SERVICES
BY AND BETWEEN
TALLADEGA COUNTY, ALABAMA,
and the CITY OF SYLACAUGA,
ALABAMA**

This Agreement made and entered into on this 5th day of August, 2024, by and between Talladega County, Alabama, (hereinafter referred to as "County") and the City of Sylacauga, Alabama, (hereinafter referred to as "City of Sylacauga").

WITNESSETH:

That, for and in consideration of the Agreement hereinafter set forth, the City of Sylacauga agrees to provide certain animal shelter services. The Agreement is as follows:

1. The City of Sylacauga agrees to provide an animal shelter for the County in the three-mile unincorporated area immediately adjacent to the City of Sylacauga. The City further agrees to accept domestic animals (dogs and cats) that are delivered to the shelter from the adjacent unincorporated area.
2. In consideration for the services to be provided by the City of Sylacauga, the County agrees to pay to the City of Sylacauga the sum of \$20,000.00 per year. Said compensation will be paid no later than December 31st, 2024.
3. The City of Sylacauga agrees to hold the County harmless from all related City operations within the three-mile unincorporated area immediately adjacent to the City of Sylacauga. The County will not be liable for any of the City's activities or the results thereof.
4. It is agreed between Talladega County and the City of Sylacauga that the term of the agreement is one year, beginning October 1st, 2024, and ending on September 30th, 2025, with subsequent annual renewals, unless terminated in writing by either party no later than thirty (30) days prior to the end of the annual term.

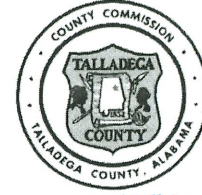

RESOLUTION

APPROVE CONTRACT FOR ANIMAL SHELTER SERVICES BETWEEN THE COUNTY AND THE CITY OF SYLACAUGA

County Administrator Pat Lyle submitted for approval a contract for animal shelter services between the County and the City of Sylacauga. As part of this agreement, the City of Sylacauga agrees to provide an animal shelter for the County in the 3-mile unincorporated area immediately adjacent to the City of Sylacauga. The city will also accept domestic animals that are delivered to the shelter from the adjacent unincorporated area. The County will pay the City of Sylacauga \$20,000 per year in return for these stated services. Commissioner Phillip Morris made a motion to approve the contract with the City of Sylacauga for animal shelter services, with a second motion by Commissioner Malley Limbaugh. Motion carried.

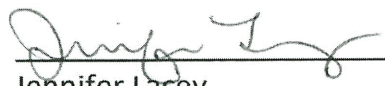
